#### LETTER FROM THE CONGREGATION FOR CATHOLIC EDUCATION VATICAN CITY, 25 MARCH 1988 THE VIRGIN MARY IN INTELLECTUAL AND SPIRITUAL FORMATION

Considering the importance of the Virgin in the history of salvation and in the life of the people of God, and after promptings of Vatican Council II and of the Popes, it would be unthinkable that the teaching of Mariology be obscured today: it is necessary, therefore, that it be given its just place in seminaries and theological faculties.

There are numerous advantages to be derived from an adequate Mariological formation in which the ardor of faith and the commitment to study are harmoniously composed:

on the *intellectual level*, so that the truth about God, about Man, about Christ and about the Church are understood the more in understanding the "truth about Mary";

on the *spiritual level*, so that such information will help a Christian to welcome the Mother of Jesus and "bring her into everything that makes up his inner life" [*Redemptoris Mater*, 45];

on the *pastoral level*, so that the Mother of the Lord may be strongly felt as a presence of grace among the Christian people.
